Christmas is a time for family, friends, and love. The Porter family was grateful to be able to spend the holiday together, and they cherished the memories they made.



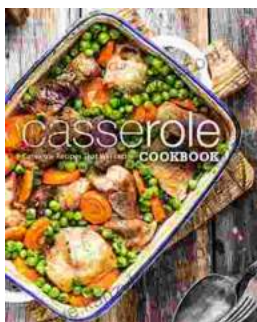
